The event is **October 2, 2009, 4 to 8 p.m. and October 3, 2009, 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.** at the Southern Maryland Artisans Center, Rte 5 at the Maryland Antique Center Complex, Leonardtown, Md. The non-refundable rental fee is \$15.00 for Crafts Guild of St. Mary's County and Chesapeake Spinners & Weavers Guild members and \$20.00 for all non-members. Applications must be received by September 15, 2009, for consideration. A space will be reserved for you on a first come-first served basis after receiving a signed application form and appropriate fee. You will be notified of space confirmation.

Section 1: Responsibilities and Conditions

By completing and signing this application, participating fiber crafters and fiber-animal farmers agree to carry out the following responsibilities in support of the event:

1. Crafters and farmers will set up their displays on October 2, 2009 between 2:30 and 4:00 p.m. and remove/disassemble their displays after 8:00 p.m. On October 3, 2009, crafters and farmers will set up their displays between 6:30 and 8:00 a.m. and remove/disassemble their displays after 3:00 p.m. **The Crafts Guild of St. Mary's County and The Maryland Antiques Center will not be held responsible for any liability of your display or animals.** (Note: Removing displays prior to the designated time may compromise participation in future Southern Maryland Artisans Center events.)
2. Table space size is limited to 10 feet. Crafters and farmers are responsible for providing their own tables and chairs. (Note: No electricity will be provided.) **Crafters and farmers are responsible for the licensing, collection, and remittance of the 6% Maryland sales tax.**
3. Crafters will ensure they sell only those products they have handcrafted themselves (as described in Section 2 below). Farmers will sell only fleece and fiber from their own animals. All vendors must display a minimum of 50% fiber or fiber-animal products and equipment for sale. **Yard and rummage sale items as well as manufactured items (except fiber related or farm equipment) will not be permitted.** (Note: Sale of used or manufactured items except as noted will be cause for ejection from the event and may compromise participation in future Southern Maryland Artisans Center events.)
